WHY HAVE WE CHANGED OUR LOOK AND FEEL?

As you know, the cruise market is more crowded, more noisy and more competitive than it's ever been. We need to stand out more and be clearer about what Fred. Olsen offers and why it's special. We're aiming to attract guests who have cruised before (but not with us) by showing them the charm, warmth, and elegance that sits at the heart of our business.

1. SMALL, THEREFORE WE VISIT MORE INTERESTING PLACES

Our ships can reach locations that would be impossible for larger vessels. Low bridges, intricate fjords and narrow canals all conspire against big ships, leaving their passengers unable to visit many of the wonderful places that our guests enjoy.

- Get all the way into beautiful Norwegian fjords like Nærøyfjord, Fjaerlandsfjord and Eresfjord
- Scenic cruising through Corinth Canal, Kiel Canal, River Seine, Loire River
- New for 2022 visit an Orangutan sanctuary in Sandakan, Malaysia
- Cruise Critic award for Itineraries winners five years in a row

2. SMALL, THEREFORE WE CAN GET MUCH CLOSER

Big ships often have to dock miles from the places they're visiting. Our ships, however, can dock right in the heart of some truly beautiful destinations

- Seville right in the heart of the city. Larger ships have to dock at Cadiz (122km away)
- Helsinki close to the market square
- Bordeaux the city is at the end of the gangway
- Funchal and Gran Canaria within walking distance of the city centre
- Copenhagen a short walk from the Little Mermaid and Amalienborg Palace
- St. Petersburg dock within view of the golden domed buildings
- Travemunde in Germany alongside the promenade of this quaint seaside resort
- Take a trip on our onboard RIBs to get even closer



3. SMALL, THEREFORE WE CAN GET YOU ON AND OFF SHIP EASILY

Smaller ships have fewer passengers (never more than 1,200 for us) and smaller groups move more smoothly and efficiently. Which is why, on a Fred. Olsen cruise, you'll be able to see more, do more and enjoy more. All with a lot less hassle.

4. SMALL, THEREFORE WE CAN BE KINDER TO THE ENVIRONMENT

We believe in reducing our impact on the environment. Our smaller ships are powered by cleaner (and more expensive) fuel, and improved engineering has significantly reduced our waste. What's more (or what's less), we've banned single-use plastics from all of our ships. Minimising our environmental impact is a journey that never ends, we're always looking for greener ways to sail the ocean waves.

5. SMALL, SO YOU CAN ENJOY A MORE PERSONAL SERVICE ON BOARD

On our smaller ships, guests will experience levels of service that other ships may be too big or too busy to provide. Unlike them, we're not trying to deal with thousands of passengers, so we can provide a genuine and caring service for each guest.

We're a family-run business, not a giant corporation, so we take great pride in the way we look after our guests and go above and beyond the kind of service you can learn from a handbook or training course.

6. SMALL, SO YOU CAN EXPLORE MORE WHEN WE TAKE YOU ASHORE

As optional extras, we offer immersive shore tours where you "discover" rather than just "see".

- St Petersburg, Russian Ballet don't just watch the ballet, meet the soloist after the performance
- Seville, A Flamenco Experience don't just watch a Flamenco performance, learn the techniques from a flamenco dancer

- Amsterdam, Tulip Fields, Farms & Festival don't just visit the Keukenhof Gardens, meet a 3rd generation tulip grower at a local tulip farm and discover more about the growing methods
