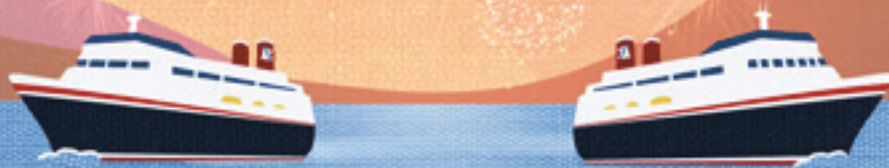

Sailing on 16th August, *Bolette* will be our newly appointed flagship. She proudly bears the name of Fred. Olsen Jnr.'s great-great-grandmother. *Borealis* is the sister ship to *Bolette*, and her maiden voyage is scheduled for 5th July. Her higher speeds are perfectly suited to carrying guests around the globe, allowing them to see more highlights along the way. This makes her perfectly suited to sail our 'Around The World In 80 Days' voyage in 2023.

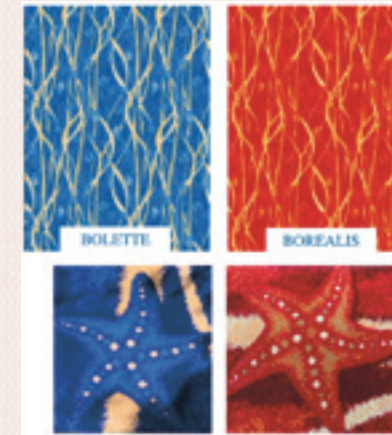
Though the largest in our fleet overall, *Bolette* and *Borealis* are still much smaller than most other cruise lines with just 700 cabins.
